Strangulation, sometimes referred to as choking or garrotting, is defined as the obstruction of blood vessels and or air flow in the neck leading to asphyxia. Strangulation is now established as a predictive risk factor for future severe domestic violence and for homicide , and it is commonly alleged by women who have experienced domestic violence.
